## A Safe and Healthy Home for Every Person

Since our founding locally in 1992, we have partnered with over 14,000 volunteers who have donated over 130,000 hours of their time to provide repairs on over 1,000 homes and three nonprofit facilities, investing a market value of \$7.2 million into communities throughout Dutchess County.

#### "This is a big thing for us, I just have to pinch myself to remind myself it is even happening." - Carole

Donald was creative and handy around the house, and so fixing up the old home was not only fun but an improvement for the family. Together, he and his wife Carole, repaired the back porch, ripped down old plaster walls and tore up flooring. But when Donald suddenly passed away, it left the home in a state of disrepair. With three generations living in the home and Carole's grandkids living with asthma, she knew she needed help.

Wappingers Falls Mayor Matt Alexander told Carole about Rebuilding Together, and on National Rebuilding Day 2019, volunteer teams from Wells Fargo Housing Foundation and Veith Electric finished the work Carole and her husband started!

"All these people are making me happy. I just want a safe home for my kids," she explained. "I love Dutchess County, I don't want to leave", insinuating that she wouldn't be able to afford to stay without having the repairs done.

Along with her daughter, P'ninah has lived in her home since 2001 and grew up in Dutchess County. With time, a retaining wall alongside her driveway started to crumble and she was afraid to park there for fear it would crumble on her car, or worse, her daughter. Friends would visit and trip over the uneven walkway and front steps, and her kitchen was unsafe, only functioning with the use of extension cords.

Thanks to teams from the United Methodist Church of Hyde Park and Veith Electric, these repairs and others were remedied. P'ninah could just jump for joy, with all the work that was done. "I won the lottery; I mean that's how it feels. It will do nothing but improve our lives for decades to come."
